Waste is collected from the canteen, rooms, and grounds and segregated at the source. Wet and dry garbage are separated at various locations on campus by Green and Blue Bins. A pit has been made to dispose of decomposable waste like fallen leaves so that the same decomposes naturally and turns into manure. 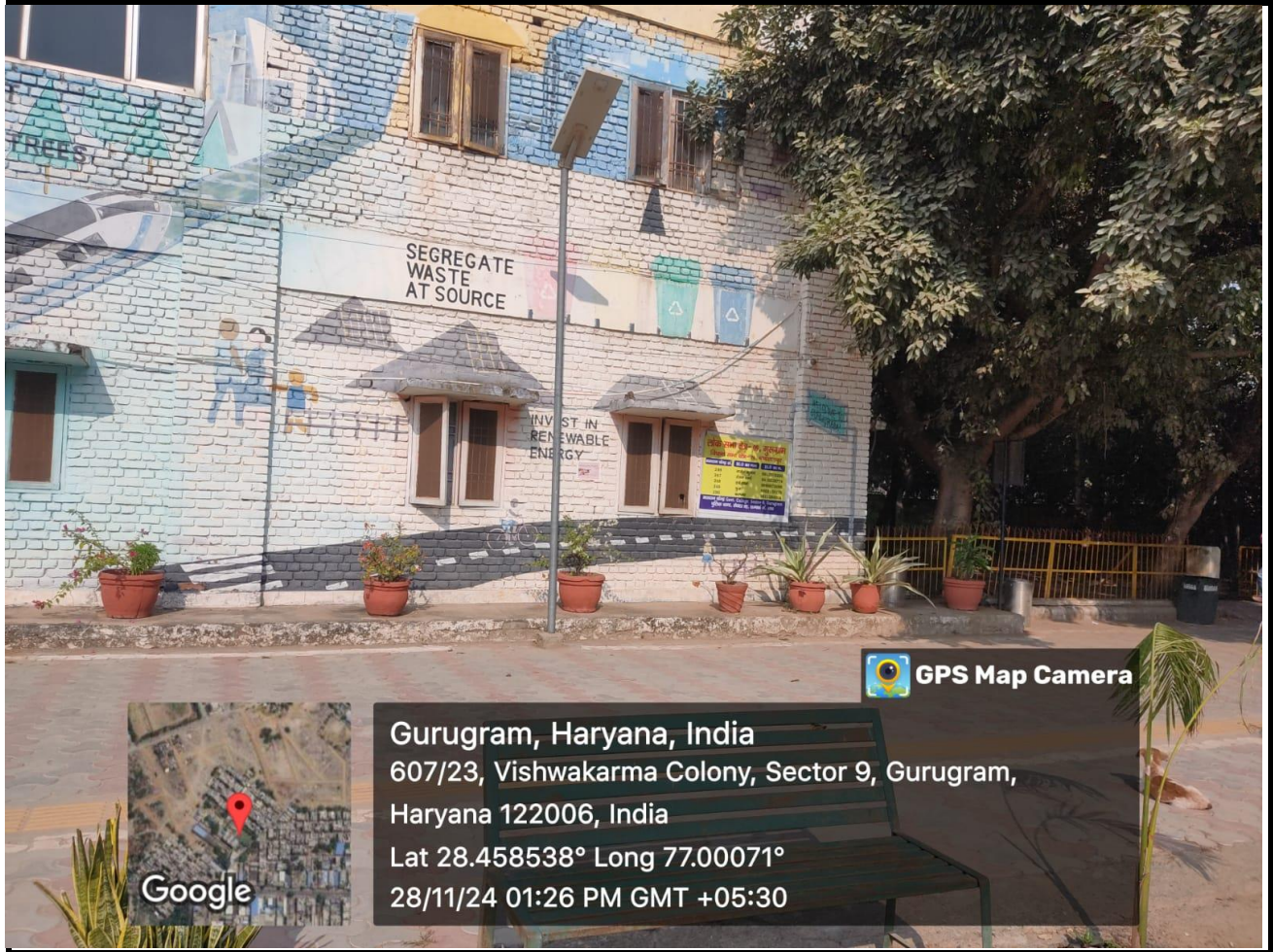
