MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

This Memorandum of Understanding (here in after called as the 'MOU') is entered into on this the March 6th, 2024 by and between **Government PG College, Sector-9, Gurugram, THE FIRST PARTY** represented herein by its Principal

AND

Indian School of Hospitality, Gurugram, THE SECOND PARTY represented herein by its Managing Director (MD).

OBJECTIVES OF MOU

In particular, this MOU is intended to:-

1. Enhancing entrepreneurial mindsets among the students by organizing workshops, training programs including startups and self-employment opportunities.
2. To exchange information regarding educational programs, teaching-learning material and other relevant information for faculty and students along with the hands on training.
3. To jointly organize seminars, conferences or workshops on topics of mutual interest.
4. To exchange on reciprocal basis, students at under graduate level for limited period of time for the purpose of education and up gradation of knowledge and skills along with the short duration faculty exchange programmes.
5. To increase collaborations and establish linkages for facilitating placements.
6. To provide guidance, knowledge and encouragement

NOW THEREFORE, IN CONSIDERATION OF THE MUTUAL PROMISES SET FORTH IN THIS MOU, THE PARTIES HERE TO AGREE AS FOLLOWS:

Clause-I

Cooperation

Both parties having mutual interests and objectives and shall establish channels of communication that will promote respective cooperation's. The parties shall keep each other informed of potential opportunities and share all information that may be relevant to secure additional opportunities for one another.

The co-operation between First Party and Second Party will facilitate effective utilization of the intellectual capabilities of the Second Party providing significant inputs & hands on training programmes to them in developing suitable teaching/training systems, keeping in mind the needs of the First Party.

Clause- II

Scope of the MOU

Both parties believe that close co-operation between the two would be beneficial for the students to enhance their skills and knowledge.

The Second Party will give valuable inputs to the First Party in teaching/training methodology so that the students fit into the industrial scenario meaningfully. The interaction between Institute and the College Centre will give an insight into the latest developments /requirements of the industries & academia. The Second Party shall permit the Faculty and Students of the First Party to visit its campus & companies and also involve in Industrial Training Programs for the First Party. The industrial training and exposure provided to the students through this association will build confidence and prepare the students to have a smooth transition from academic to working career. The Second Party will provide its Labs/Workshops/ Industrial Sites for the hands-on training of the learners enrolled with the First Party.

The Second Party will train the students of the First Party on the emerging technologies in order to bridge the gap in skill and make them ready for higher studies and career in industry.

The Second Party will extend the necessary support to deliver guest lecturers to the students of the First Party on the technology trends and in house requirements.

The Second Party will actively engage in the training, internship and placement of students of the First Party. The Second party will act as a Mentor for overall devolvement of the students and faculty in academia, skill enhancement, research and overall professional development.

Clause- III

Coordination

Both the parties will appoint one member of their staff to coordinate the programme on its behalf. Further the coordination committee, consisting of

- a. Principal, Government P.G. College, Sector-9, Gurugram*
- b. MD, Indian School Of Hospitality, Gurugram*
- c. Program Coordinator of First Party*
- d. Program Coordinator of Second Party*

Will periodically review and identify ways to strengthen cooperation between the two parties.

Clause - IV

Validity

The validity of the agreement is 03 (Three) years from the date of agreement. The MOU will take effect from the date it is signed by representatives of both the parties. It will remain valid for 03 (Three) years, and may be continued there after suitable review and agreement. Both Parties may terminate this MOU upon 30 calendar days' notice in writing. In the event of termination both the parties will have to discharge their obligations.

Clause- V**Arbitration Clause**

Should there be a dispute relating to any aspect of the MOU, Principal Government P.G. College, Sector-9, Gurugram and MD of Indian School Of Hospitality, Gurugram. Party will jointly resolve the dispute in a spirit of independence, mutual respect and shared responsibility. Further help of an independent Arbitrator could be solicited.


